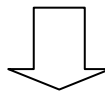

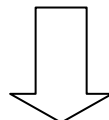

(Progress to Year 2 requires completion of Year 1 elements)

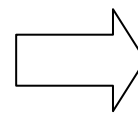
Issues in Freedom of Information Law (covering topical issues such as access to environmental information, medical information etc)(30 credits) (Semester 1)

Work based project (30 credits) (Semester 2)*



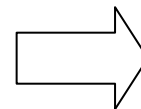
Year 3

(Progress to year 3 requires completion of year 2 elements)

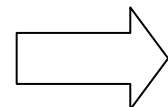
